School Starting Dates 2016

The school office opens on Wednesday 27th January 2016. Students in Years 1 to 6 return to school on Thursday 28th January. There will be staggered visits for our Kindergarten children to complete their Best Start Assessments on Thursday 28th and Friday 29th January. Kindergarten students will then start school together on Monday 1st February at 9.30am and finish at 3.00pm. From the Tuesday, Kinder students will start at normal school time but continue to finish 15mins before the end of the regular school day for approximately two weeks. A separate letter with the specific date and time children are to attend for their Best Start Assessment will be sent 2016 Kindergarten families.


We had a fantastic turnout for the cupcake day on Tuesday. Many thanks to all the parents who baked and especially to the mums who came to help sell the cakes.

For the last few weeks of term we will be focussing on Christmas craft and cooking.


