Subsidised School Travel

A new online School Student Transport Scheme (SSTS) application process has been introduced for schools within the Opal network, coinciding with the introduction of the School Opal card. Most parents, guardians and students won't need to apply for a school travel pass for 2016 if a school student travel pass for the current year has already been issued. These will be automatically sent to the school by Transport for NSW for term one 2016.

However, students should use the new form if they:

- are just starting school and have not had a pass for travel before
- are moving from year 2 to 3 or year 6 to 7
- are changing schools or campus, including going between primary and secondary school
- or, if their personal details have changed (e.g. address)
