Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with a Disability

Since 2015, all schools in Australia are required to participate annually in the Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with a Disability. Involvement in the national data collection will assist schools to gain a greater understanding of their student population and how students can be best supported formally and consistently, recognise the support and adjustments provided to students with disability in the school.

To develop the professional judgement of school teams in making adjustments for students' disability rather than relying on medical/clinical diagnosis alone include all eligible students in the annual data collection from 2015.

It is important to note that students who do not have a clinical diagnosis, but for whom there is an adjustment made within learning programs, will be included in the NCCD in 2017.


